

What Insurances do we accept?

We are open access practice, We accept all Medicaid programs, most commercial insurances. We offer a discounted self pay plan for patients without insurance.

Important Note: Please remember to add your new baby to your insurance plan as soon as possible and no later than 30 days after birth. If your baby is not added to your policy, it can be extremely complicated to obtain coverage for your child.

Patient Portal - Our patient portal is a secure online website that gives you convenient, 24-hour access to your child's personal health information from anywhere with an Internet connection. Using a secure username and password, parents can view health information such as recent office visits with our provider, lab and/or radiology results. Additionally, parents can update demographics, complete forms and questionnaires, request prescription refills, access educational materials, and request appointments through Healow.

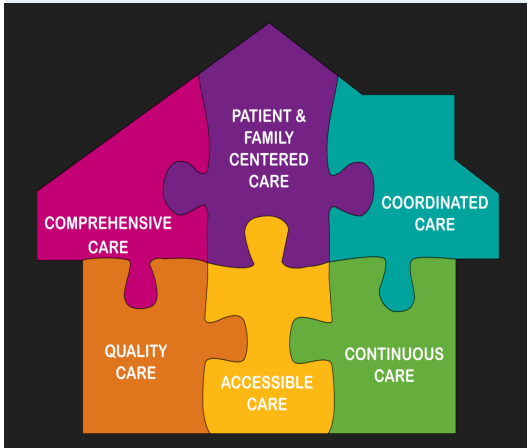

- Notify us regarding any visits that you have made for your child outside our office.
